SUMMARY

A preliminary analysis shows that 133 persons died in fires in the period April - June 1971. Of these 118 were in England and Wales and 15 in Scotland.

The most serious incident was at a London hotel when nine people died in a fire attributed to arson.

Introduction

A preliminary analysis of casualties in fires in the second quarter of 1971 shows that 133 persons died in fires attended by fire brigades. That is one fewer than the corresponding provisional figure in 1970. Of these, 118 were reported in England and Wales and 15 in Scotland. No reports have been received of any fatalities in Northern Ireland during the second quarter.

The most serious incident during the quarter was at a London hotel in which nine people died in a fire attributed to arson. Another incident in a house in Hampshire led to the deaths of five children. Four persons died in a fire in a terraced house in Bradford.

Tables 1 - 4 give details of hazard, time of call, source of ignition and dates of construction (where applicable) with respect to fatal fires. Table 5A gives the age and sex distribution of fatal casualties, and the causes of death are given in Table 5B. The numbers of fatal and non-fatal casualties on each brigade area are shown in Table 6.

This analysis is based on reports received up to 30 July 1971 and is subject to revision when outstanding reports and further information are received.
